Recommendation

SME research collaborations via common bilateral calls

- Funding of co-operative research projects by grants
- Open to all technologies
- Applications should be made at any time; open tender, fast approval processes (time to contract: 3 months)
- Rate of funding: up to 50 % for companies, up to 100 % for R&D establishments



Why?

Strong support of international research co-operations of SMEs

How?

Common **bilateral calls** in the frame of bilateral collaboration agreements

Each country finances its companies/research institutions with respect to **national funding rules**

Example:

Central Innovation Programme Germany (about 80 international projects p.a.)

- 10 % bonus for international co-operations
- bilateral collaboration agreements and common calls with: Alberta (Canada), Vietnam, South Korea, Russia, Finland, Wallonia & Flanders (Belgium), Austria, Czech Republic, Nord-pas de Calais (France)
