Questions during the Webinar Horizon 2020 Administrative Basics

1. Did the bilateral agreement between the EC and US ever get amended and signed?

The S&T Agreement between the US and the European Union has been signed in 1998. It has been renewed since in 2004, 2009 and just recently in 2014 for another 5 years.

2. How is the PADOR (Potential Applicant Data On-Line Registration) number related to this process (the PIC process in H2020)?

The Potential Applicant Data On-Line Registration is an online database of another EC Directorate General: DG DEVCO. The respective funding programme is called "EuropeAid" and deals with development aid being a separate programme from H2020.

PADOR is an on-line database in which organizations register as potential applicants to calls within the programme **EuropeAid** - Building partnerships for change in developing countries. Organizations are invited to regularly update their information, and EuropeAid uses it to evaluate their operational and financial capacity, as well as their eligibility to participate in calls for proposals.

PADOR eases the application process for organizations, as they are not obliged to re-submit this information separately each time they participate in a call. They simply indicate their unique identification number, called EuropeAid ID (PADOR number), in their application forms.

If you have a Partner Identification Code (PIC) for H2020 it is not sufficient for calls within the above mentioned EuropeAid programme. You will need to get a unique EuropeAid ID PADOR number in order to be able to apply and be eligible for EuropeAid calls.
