

FP7 (2007-2013)

- Four programmes to strengthen EU public and private R&D
- New: Public Private Partnerships with large industry
- SMEs: Target of 15% of EU funding
- ♦ <u>€6 billion for the Health theme</u>





FP7 Health Cooperation programme

- **5,5** € billion invested
- 1,050 projects
- 12,500 teams
- 3,600 organisations
- **123** countries


First outcomes (on 370 finished projects)

- **230** patent applications
- 12,500 publications


162 US organisations accounting for **196** participations:

- SMEs: dedicated instrument & financial instruments

What about EU-US projects in H2020?



- US organisations are funded in Societal Challenge 1 Health (exc. SME instrument topic)
- US organisations can if essential be funded elsewhere in H2020 (e.g. biotech, environment, space, transport programmes)
- For most topics: minimum 3 project partners from 3 EU-28 countries or Associated countries*

*Albania, Bosnia and Herzigovina, Faroe Islands, former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia, Iceland, Israel, Liechtenstein, Moldova, Montenegro, Norway, Serbia and Turkey



Upcoming call: Personalising Health and Care (PHC)-2015

Some topics of the PHC-2015 call:

- PHC-11-2015: Development of new diagnostic tools and technologies: in vivo medical imaging technologies
- PHC-14-2015: New therapies for rare diseases
- PHC-15-2015: Clinical research on regenerative medicine
- PHC-16-2015: Tools and technologies for advanced therapies
- PHC-21-2015: Advancing active and healthy ageing with ICT: Early risk detection and intervention
- PHC-24-2015: Piloting personalised medicine in health and care systems
- PHC-25-2015: Advanced ICT systems and services for integrated care
- PHC-33-2015: New approaches to improve predictive human safety testing

Budget: € 492 million – Deadline: 14/10/2014





How to apply?

- **1.** Read the call, identify a relevant topic
- **2. Find EU partners**
- **3.** Write and submit your proposal
- 4. Get funded (10% success rate)
